Bethel Park, the 70 acre wooded day use park owned and operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on the shores of Lake Sydney Lanier is in danger of being permanently closed to public use.

The YMCA of Greater Atlanta intends to lease Bethel Park and create a summer camp for the use of YMCA campers from outside the local area. As a result, Bethel Park will cease to exist as a public park.

In 2005, over 21,528 people visited Bethel Park. Bethel Park offers hiking, jogging, fishing, boating and swimming opportunities for the general public. If the YMCA succeeds, the current facilities will be removed and all current visitors will be prohibited from accessing Bethel Park.

We can save Bethel Park. Forsyth County can lease Bethel Park and continue to operate it as a public park open to all visitors!
